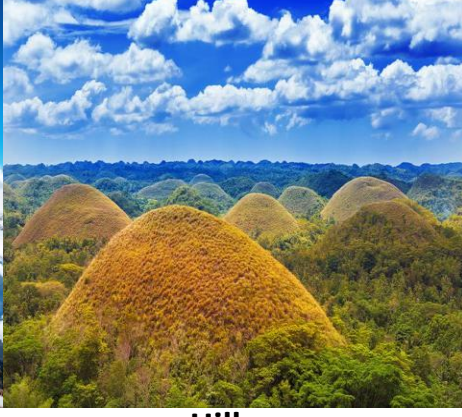

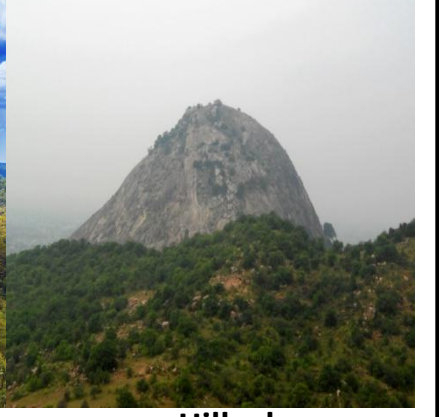

Q:- What is difference between mountain and hill?

A.

1. There is no universally accepted definition of mountain.
2. Elevation, relief, steepness, spacing and continuity have been used as criteria for defining a mountain.
3. Whether a land form is a mountain may depend on local usage
Eg: - Mount Scott, Oklahoma, USA, is only 251 meters (823feet) from its base to its highest point is defined as mountain.
4. Whittos dictionary of physical geography states above 600 meters (2000feet) as mountain. Those below being referred as Hills.
5. In the United kingdom and Ireland a mountain is usually defined as any summit at least 2000 feet (or 610 meters) high.
6. Hills are easier to climb than mountain, hills are usually less steep than mountain, but there is no official distinction between Mountains and Hills.
7. Many geographers state that a mountain is greater than 1000 feet above sea level.
8. Hillock:- A hillock is a small hill, usually separated from a larger group of hills.
