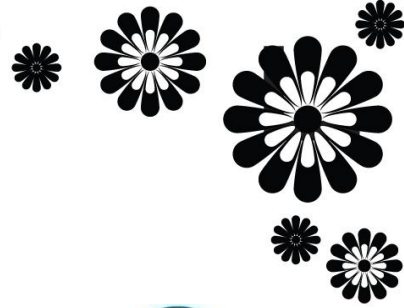

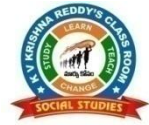

RECORDING OF INFORMATION

Aung San Suu Kyi, sometimes abbreviated to **Suu Kyi**, is a Burmese politician, diplomat, author, and a 1991 Nobel Peace Prize laureate who served as State Counsellor of Myanmar and Minister of Foreign Affairs from 2016 to 2021. She has served as the chairperson of the National League for Democracy (NLD) since 2011, having been the general secretary from 1988 to 2011. She played a vital role in Myanmar's transition from military junta to partial democracy in the 2010s.



Name:

Aung San Suu Kyi, like other Burmese names, includes no surname, but is only a personal name, in her case derived from three relatives: "[Aung San](#)" from her father, "Suu" from her paternal grandmother, and "Kyi" from her mother Khin Kyi.



In Myanmar, Aung San Suu Kyi is often referred to as *Daw* Aung San Suu Kyi. *Daw*, literally meaning "aunt", is not part of her name but is an honorific for any older and revered woman, akin to "Madam". She is sometimes addressed as **Daw Suu** or **Amay Suu** ("Mother Suu") by her supporters.



Personal life:

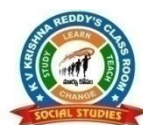
Aung San Suu Kyi was born on 19 June 1945 in Rangoon (now Yangon), British Burma. According to Peter Popham, she was born in a small village outside Rangoon called Hmway Saung.



Her father, Aung San, allied with the Japanese during World War II. Aung San founded the modern Burmese army and negotiated Burma's independence from the United Kingdom in 1947; he was assassinated by his rivals in the same year. She is a niece of Thakin Than Tun who was the husband of Khin Khin Gyi, the elder sister of her mother Khin Kyi.

House arrest :

Aung San Suu Kyi was placed under house arrest for a total of 15 years over a 21-year period, on numerous occasions, since she began her political career, during which time she was prevented from meeting her party supporters and international visitors.

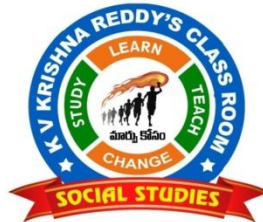
Health problems :

Aung San Suu Kyi underwent surgery for a gynecological condition in September 2003 at Asia Royal Hospital during her house arrest. She also underwent minor foot surgery in December 2013 and eye surgery in April 2016. In June 2012, her doctor Tin Myo Win said that she had no serious health problems.

Justice Abdul Nazeer to take oath as AP Governor today

Justice Abdul Nazeer to take oath as AP Governor today

Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, along with his spouse Bharathi, met AP Governor-designate Justice Abdul Nazeer and his wife Sameera Nazeer at the Raj Bhavan here on Thursday. Justice Nazeer is all set to take oath as Governor of Andhra Pradesh at a swearing-in ceremony scheduled at the Raj Bhavan on Friday at 9 am.

AP High Court Chief Justice Prashant Kumar Mishra will administer the oath of office to the new Governor. Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy, along with his cabinet colleagues, public representatives and state officials, will attend the oath-taking ceremony.

Justice Abdul Nazeer, who retired on January 4 this year as a judge of the Supreme Court, will be the third Governor of AP. After bifurcation of the state, E.S.L. Narasimhan had served as the AP Governor from June 2, 2014 to July 23, 2019. After

that, Biswabhusan Harichandan from Odisha had been appointed as AP Governor, who continued in the post for 43 months. Harichandan has been transferred as Governor of Chhattisgarh.

Born on January 5, 1958, at Beluvai in Moodabidari taluk of Karnataka, Justice Nazeer did his B.A. in Mahaveera College there. He completed his law degree from Kodiyalbil SDM Law College, Mangalore. He enrolled as an advocate on February 18, 1983, and

started his legal practice in the Karnataka High Court. He got appointed Additional Judge of Karnataka HC on May 12, 2003. He had been promoted as Permanent Judge on September 24, 2004.

Justice Nazeer had been appointed as Supreme Court Judge on February 17, 2017. He retired as the SC Judge on January 4, 2023. As judge of the apex court, Justice Nazeer heard priority cases like Triple Talaq, Ram Janmabhoomi and Demonetisation.

Analysis of the News Item

Mr. Abdul Nazir has been appointed as the new Governor of Andhra Pradesh replacing Hari Chandan who has been the Governor for the past 43 months. He was the third person to be appointed after the partition of Andhra Pradesh.

Honorable Chief Minister YS Jaganmohan Reddy and many dignitaries along with Cabinet Ministers participated in the recent oath taking ceremony.

Held important responsibilities in Karnataka High Court and other judicial positions. He was active in cases like triple talaq, Ram Janmabhoomi and demonetisation.

Let's hope that his efforts in good governance and sustainable development will be towards giving good results in the coming days
